The CY2027 IDOC Grant Applications are now open and available online through EUNA. The IDOC has \$52.9M available to award in grant funding for CY2027. All grant applications and supporting documents must be submitted via EUNA no later than **April 1, 2026. If qualified agencies in the Cass/Pulaski Region are submitted applications they must be approved by the CCAB and prioritized, even if funding was terminated in a prior year.** Court Services Director and Cass County Grant Administrator has begun the grant application and writing process.

Each agency will present its application for discussion and questions. The Board will then review, approve, and prioritize the applications. A formal approval and prioritization letter will follow.
