Your conviction on the above cause will result in compliance with the following special stipulations during your term of Community Corrections. You will verify your understanding of terms by initialing the associated box.

STIPULATIONS FOR SEX OFFENDERS

DEFINITIONS:

- Child or children is/are any person or persons under the age of eighteen (18) years.
- Contact means face-to-face, telephonic, correspondence, electronic communication, or indirect contact via third party.
- Electronic communication involves using the internet, the interconnection of communications with a computer or wireless telecommunication device, texting, emailing, chatting, private chat rooms, social media sites, and any other method of communication that exists through the world wide web or other types of means of electronic communication.
- Electronic communication devices include any computer, tablet, telephone, cellular telephone, personal digital assistant, flash drive, solid state drive, pager, and any instrument, device, machine, equipment, software, and cloud storage that can transfer or store any signs, signals, writing, images, sounds, data, or intelligence of any nature transmitted or stored in whole or in part by a wire, radio or electronic system.

STIPULATIONS:

1. You shall enroll in, actively participate in, and successfully complete an approved sex offender treatment program along with any other recommended treatment programs. You must maintain steady progress toward goals and may not change treatment providers without prior approval of community corrections. Treatment is considered a behavioral management requirement of your community corrections and may include plethysmograph or polygraph testing or similar assessment/management tools. Termination from treatment or non-compliance with other required behavioral management requirements will be considered a violation of your community corrections agreement. Subsequent treatment referrals, if any, will be at the direction of community corrections. Should you request and be permitted to change treatment providers, stricter stipulations may be applied. Prompt payment of any fees is your responsibility.

2. You shall sign any waiver of confidentiality, release of information, or any documents required to permit community corrections, probation, and/or behavioral management or treatment providers to examine any and all records, to collaboratively share and discuss your behavioral management conditions, treatment progress, and community corrections/probation needs as a team. This permission may extend to (1) sharing your relapse prevention plan and treatment progress with your significant others and/or your victim and victim's therapist as directed by community corrections or treatment

provider(s) and (2) sharing of your modus operandi behaviors with law enforcement personnel.

3. You must inform all persons living in your residence of current and previous sex-related convictions before establishing residency, as verified by community corrections. You shall notify community corrections of any change in home situations or marital status within twenty-four (24) hours. You shall have only one residence and one mailing address at a time.

4. You shall not touch, photograph (still or moving), contact, and/or engage in “small talk” or unnecessary conversation with any child or someone you believe to be a child. This includes your biological, adopted, step, foster, and/or grandchildren either directly or indirectly or via a third party, or attempt to do any of the preceding without written approval in advance by community corrections in consultation with your treatment provider. Any contact with biological and/or adopted children must be granted through a court order. You must never be in any vehicle, including a ride-sharing program, or any residence with any child, including those previously listed, even if other adults (s) are present, without written approval in advance by community corrections in consultation with your treatment provider. You must report any unintended contact with children, including those previously listed, to community corrections within twenty-four (24) hours of contact.

5. You are prohibited from residing within one thousand (1,000) feet of public parks, schools, and/or youth program centers. You shall not enter, travel through, or intentionally loiter within one thousand (1,000) feet of any place that children are reasonably expected to gather or congregate, including but not limited to parks, schools, playgrounds, sporting events, public swimming pools, nature trails, public beaches, libraries, movie theaters, county/state fairgrounds, amusement parks, and shopping malls. You shall not reside within (1) one mile of any of the victims in this offense and previous sex offenses.

6. You shall have no contact with your victim or victim’s family unless community corrections grant prior approval in coordination with your treatment provider and victim(s) treatment provider. Contact will only occur under special supervised conditions.

7. You shall comply with any medical or mental health treatment or assessment, and any other behavioral management stipulations as required by community corrections. You will only participate in behavioral management programs approved by community corrections. You will not miss appointments for psychotherapy, counseling, or community service obligations without the prior approval of community corrections or treatment providers. You will not discontinue taking prescribed medication without the approval of your prescribing physician, and you must notify community corrections and your treatment provider within three (3) working days of discontinuing the medication.

8. You shall not possess or view any obscene materials, which, for the purpose of this stipulation, is what the average person, applying contemporary community standards, finds that the dominant theme of the material, taken as a whole, appears to be a morbid, degrading, and unhealthy interest in sex; depicts or describes, in a patently offensive way, sexual conduct; and taken as a whole, lacks serious literary, artistic, political, or scientific value. This includes materials that describe or portray human nudity, exploitation of children, consensual sex acts, nonconsensual sex acts involving force or violence, or any other material deemed to be sexually arousing including, but not limited to, the following: hard copy (magazine, photo, etc.); internet websites; social networking sites; streaming services; photographs, drawings; audio/video tapes, CDs / DVDs / blu-rays, flash drives,

cell phones or any digital storage device containing photographs displaying nudity, magazines, books, literature, writings or any other material deemed to be sexually arousing as determined by Community Corrections. You may not enter any adult entertainment or strip clubs, peep shows, bars where topless or exotic dancers perform, adult novelty or adult bookstores, or other businesses that specialize in the distribution or sales of sexually oriented materials. You may not utilize sexually oriented telephone services or engage in sexual activity or contact for the exchange of money, property, or services. You shall not possess any sex toys, devices, or aids.

9. You shall not possess or access personal contact materials, including online dating and relationship websites and applications, magazines, newspapers, or other auditory, telephonic, electronic, or printed materials that contain information about persons who seek sexual contact with others. You shall not seek sexual contact with others by way of personal contact materials or electronic communications.

10. You are only permitted to possess electronic communication devices approved by Community Corrections. You shall not obtain, access, or operate any electronic communication device without prior approval from Community Corrections. You shall not use any electronic communication device with any internet connection at any location (including place of employment) without prior approval from Community Corrections. You shall not use or access social networking applications or websites to communicate, directly or through a third party, with any person.

11. Upon request from Community Corrections at any time at their discretion, you shall allow community corrections, probation, law enforcement personnel, and/or their designee to conduct a periodic warrantless examination of your electronic device(s), which may include retrieval and copying of all files from your device(s) and any internal or external peripherals to ensure compliance with your stipulations. You shall immediately provide all associated usernames and passwords to the device(s) upon request from Community Corrections. This may require removing such equipment to conduct a more thorough inspection. You shall also consent to installing any hardware or software systems on your electronic communication device(s) with internet capability, at your expense, to monitor internet usage. You shall not have access to passwords or stored data on any electronic communication device shared with another person. You are prohibited from using any application or method to password-protect, hide, lock, or otherwise conceal any prohibited material from inspection. You are prohibited from using encryption software or deleting, erasing, or tampering with information on your electronic communication device that conceals any prohibited activity.

12. You shall not possess or use alcohol or any illegal controlled substance at any time.

13. You shall not frequent or be at any establishment whose main business purpose is selling, distributing, serving, or drinking alcoholic beverages or illegal controlled substances.

14. You shall, at the direction of community corrections, submit to a substance abuse evaluation and follow all treatment recommendations.

15. You shall submit to breath (e.g. alco-sensor), urine, blood, saliva, and/or DNA testing as ordered by community corrections.

16. You shall not drive via any motorized or non-motorized vehicle, walk, ride by, or be close to any areas, public or private, where persons under the age of eighteen (18) are known to congregate or could be reasonably or are usually expected to congregate unless you have good cause and no feasible alternative route is available. These areas include, but are not limited to: schools, public or private parks, playgrounds, beaches, swimming pools, theaters, and daycare centers.

17. You shall not hitchhike or pick up hitchhikers.

18. You are not permitted to leave your approved residence during curfew hours (9:00 pm – 5:00 am local time) unless you receive prior approval from Community Corrections, who can adjust your curfew as necessary.

19. You shall, without prior approval from community corrections, not travel alone (including but not limited to driving, walking, bicycling, etc.) after dark.

20. You shall not stay overnight with any adult and/or engage, establish, pursue or maintain any sexual relationship with any person without prior approval from Community Corrections in consultation with your treatment provider. You shall not associate with any person or family with minor children unless you receive prior approval from Community Corrections in consultation with your treatment provider. You must also report whether the person you are having a relationship with has children under eighteen (18) and/or if children under eighteen (18) reside in the person's home.

21. You shall not use your employment to acquire new victims. Community Corrections may contact your employer at any time. You will not work in certain occupations that involve being in the private residences of others, such as, but not limited to, door-to-door sales, soliciting, or delivery. Community corrections must first approve any employment that you engage in.

22. You shall not possess any items on your person, in your vehicle, in your place of residence, or as part of your personal effects which attract children or that may be used to coerce children to engage in inappropriate or illegal sexual activities. You will not attempt to persuade, whether by words or actions or both, a child or someone you believe to be a child to enter a vehicle, structure, or enclosed area or to relocate otherwise.

23. You shall not join or be associated with any group that promotes activities involving children under the age of eighteen (18) years of age, such as, but not limited to: church or religious youth groups, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, Brownies, YMCA, YWCA, Big Brothers/Big Sisters, youth sports teams, public parks, etc.

24. You shall consent to, participate in, and complete periodic polygraph testing at the direction of community corrections or any other behavioral management professionals who are providing treatment or assisting community corrections in monitoring your compliance with community corrections rules and special stipulations. You shall make payment of any co-pays to the polygraph provider before all scheduled polygraph testing.

25. You shall be under intensive supervision for Three Hundred Sixty-Five (365) days and report to community corrections as frequently as community corrections instruct. Thereafter, you shall report as frequently as instructed.

26. You shall register with local law enforcement authorities as a sex offender within seventy-two (72) hours of being released to community corrections or as instructed by community corrections. You shall continue to register your approved residence, employment, vehicles, e-mail, social media accounts, and passwords, according to Indiana Code while on community corrections supervision.

27. You shall agree to permit the installation, maintenance, and operation of any electronic monitoring equipment in your home and your person.

28. You shall not possess or operate an unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) for the purpose of surveillance, following, contacting, or capturing images or recordings of one (1) or more other individuals.

29. Upon request from Community Corrections, you shall allow community corrections, with or without the assistance of probation, law enforcement personnel and/or computer service representative, to conduct a periodic warrantless search of your residence, vehicles registered and/or used by you, outbuilding(s) on your property and any other location on your property. This may include removal of property to conduct a more thorough inspection.

30. Special Conditions:

*You shall abide by all terms and conditions of probation.

*You shall abide by all terms and conditions of parole.

*You shall abide by all terms and conditions of the sex/violent offender registry.

I, the undersigned Defendant, have reviewed and understand the stipulations above. I understand that failure to comply with any of said terms may result in my removal from Community Corrections and filing with the Court, which may result in the revocation of my sentence.
